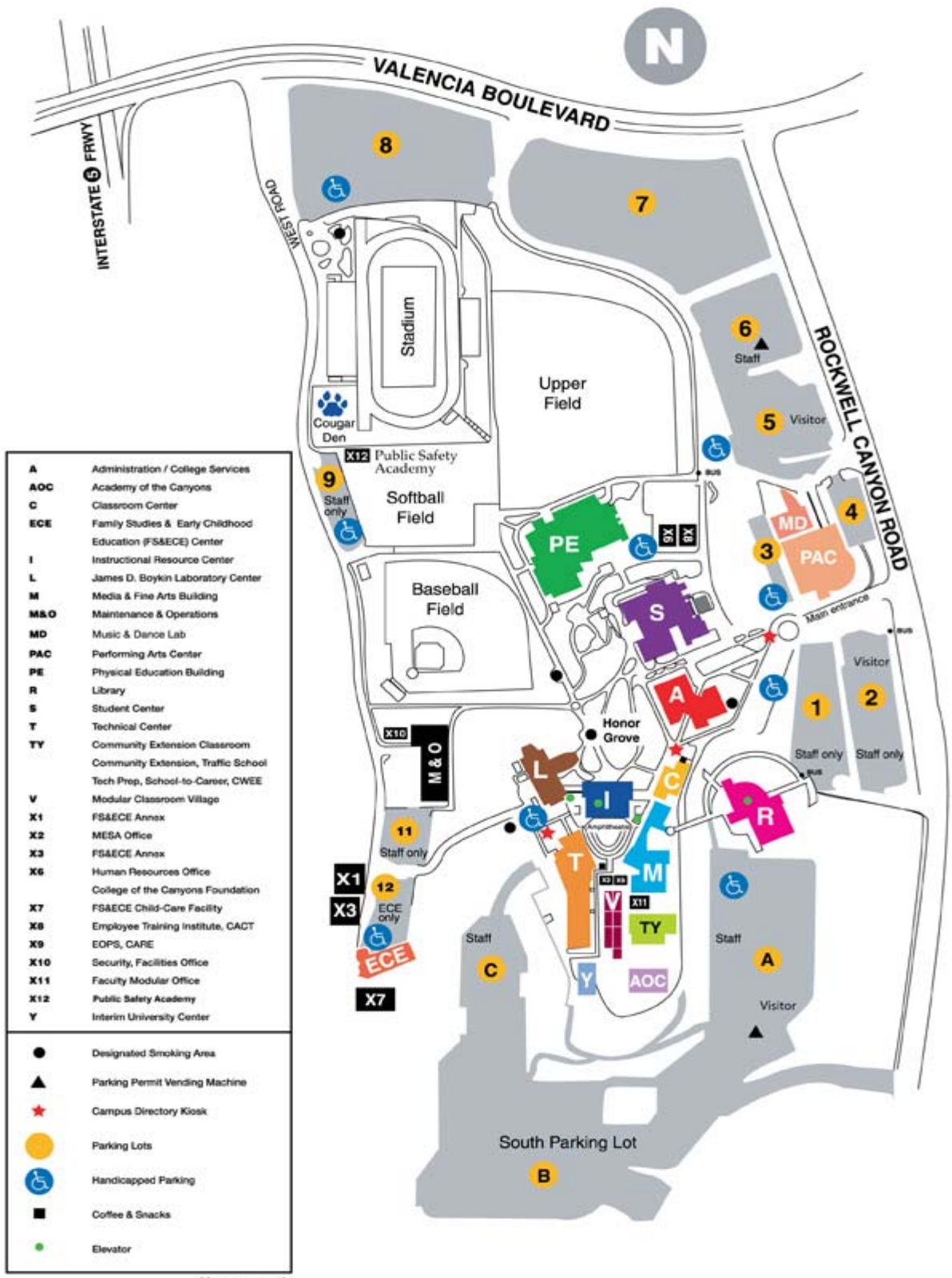

General directions to College of the Canyons from various geographic areas:

*Please Note: Campus parking permits **ARE NOT** required in the month of January.*

Inland Empire:

1. Take Interstate 210 (WEST). (there is generally moderate traffic when you reach Irwindale [605 Fwy interchange] from 8:00am until 10am)
2. Proceed (NORTH) on Interstate 5.
3. EXIT Valencia Blvd. Turn RIGHT.
4. Turn RIGHT on Rockwell Canyon Road.
5. Turn RIGHT onto the main campus entrance. Park anywhere in the Visitor's lot on the left.

Orange County:

1. Take Interstate 5 (NORTH). (there can be moderate to heavy traffic when you reach Artesia [Paramount Blvd] through Dodger's Stadium [110 Fwy interchange] )
2. Continue (NORTH) on Interstate 5.
3. EXIT Valencia Blvd. Turn RIGHT.
4. Turn RIGHT on Rockwell Canyon Road.
5. Turn RIGHT onto the main campus entrance. Park anywhere in the Visitor's lot on the left.

Los Angeles County:

1. Take Interstate 5 (NORTH).
2. Proceed (NORTH) on Interstate 5 to Valencia Blvd.
3. EXIT Valencia Blvd. Turn RIGHT.
4. Turn RIGHT on Rockwell Canyon Road.
5. Turn RIGHT onto the main campus entrance. Park anywhere in the Visitor's lot on the left.
