The issue of the inability by various institutions, LEMSAs etc to share the results of the Live Scan causes a financial burden for the students. The hospitals are not consistent in what they require for back ground checks. Concern raised about the clinical experience required by Title 22 may be changed from not doing ER time but limited strictly to ambulance experience. ROP training programs cannot require a clean background check as prerequisite. Elaine reported that the BRN is not taking a stand and discretion by instructor determines whether student is cleared. Important to relay the information to the students at the beginning of the class and let the student self determine.
